



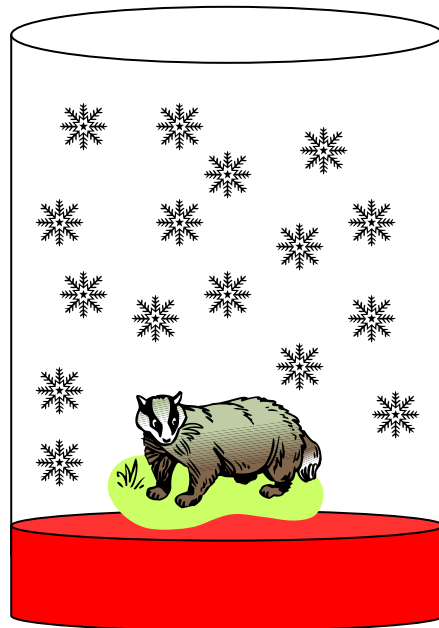
Christmas Badger Snowstorm



1. You will need: glycerine, water, strong glue, glitter, model badger.
2. Choose a very small jar, with a very tight screw-top lid. Test it before you use it!
3. Put some glycerine into the jar and mix with water in ratio of about 1:2 glycerine to water. Add the glitter and stir well.
4. Make a badger from plasticine or clay. You could draw one and then cover it carefully in plastic or laminate it. Stick it to the underside of the lid with a strong, waterproof glue.
5. For an extra seal, add some glue to the threads of the lid before you screw it on to prevent leakage.



6. Now you could decorate the sides of the lid. Run some glue around it and sprinkle some glitter around it.
7. Turn you jar upside down and shake.



As the winter weather moves in, badgers spend less time out foraging and more time sleeping in the sett. It is more difficult to find food at this time of the year. They do NOT hibernate. By December, their levels of activity have slowed right down, and they reduce their body temperature to save energy. Hopefully, they will have put on lots of fat over the autumn to see them through the winter.
