Why not build a pebble pool in your garden? It is a way of providing water for wildlife and giving your children an opportunity to watch the wildlife at close quarters.


The pebble pool is an up-turned dustbin lid, filled with pebbles from a riverbank, etc. You could drop in a few interesting stones or fossils.

Once full, the water is poured over the top. As most of the volume of the pool is taken up with stones, there is very little water to provide any sort of risk.




Keep topped up, preferable with rainwater, (it doesn't contain chemicals), and birds and insects
